The Directors of The Muslim Jewish Forum of Greater Manchester present their annual report together with the financial statements for the year to 30 June 2010.

Principal Activities

The objects for which the Forum is established are to develop the cultural and social ties between the Muslim and Jewish Communities of Greater Manchester; to educate members of the Muslim and Jewish Communities in relation to their shared values and common Abrahamic tradition, heritage, history and culture; and to promote better understanding within the wider community of the interests and values that are common to the Muslim and Jewish Communities.

During the period, the Forum has held a number of events to further these objects. They included:

- <u>12th July 2009 -</u> We held a Politicians' Event at Manchester Town Hall with Ivan Lewis MP, Cllr Michelle Wiseman, Lord Ahmed and Cllr Abu Chaudhry. The meeting was chaired by Cllr Maryam Khan and it was attended by approximately 50 people.
- 18th October 2009 We held our Muslim Jewish Forum 5th Anniversary Party at the Nicky Alliance Day Centre which was attended by approximately 45 people.
- 16th November 2009 We held a joint Event with the Joseph Inter Faith Foundation at Manchester University regarding the Threat of the BNP to our Communities. The speakers included our Co- Chair Cllr Afzal Khan CBE and Muslim and Jewish students. The Event was attended by approximately 50 people.
- 21st February 2010 We held a Kosher Chinese Luncheon at Pagoda Chinese Restaurant which was attended by 15 people.
- 21st March 2010 We held a "Women's Event" at Venture Arts in Hulme. It was an interactive day of Drama and Art and was organised by Laura Nathan and Nikki Mailer assisted by Aimee Banay and Yasmin Bibi. It was attended by approximately 60 women.
- 24th May 2010- We held an Inter Faith Dialogue Event jointly with FN4M on "Faith Says.....on Education and Learning."
- 10th May -14th May 2010- Five members of the Forum visited sites of Muslim and Jewish interest in Granada and Cordoba in Spain.
- 15th June 2010- We held our 5th Lawyers and Accountants Event at the offices of Linder Myers. It was entitled "The Law and Domestic Violence in Muslim and Jewish Communities". The speakers were Iris Chaytow and Priya Chopra and the Event was attended by approximately 50 people.
- <u>22nd June 2010 -</u> We held an Inter Faith Dialogue Event jointly with FN4M on "Faith says......about Gender."

We also ran several other events jointly with other organisations through Faiths in Action funding:

- 30th September 2009 First Monthly Faith Dialogue, joint with FN4M, at Manchester Jewish Museum, Cheetham Hill Road.
- <u>16th November 2009 -</u> Faith and the Environment Conference, joint with FN4M, at MERCi (Manchester Environmental Resource Centre).
- 19th January 2010 Monthly Faith Dialogue, joint with FN4M, at Shakespeare House on the theme "JOURNEYS". Mominah Choudhury reflected on her personal experience of the Hajj, the annual Muslim pilgrimage to Mecca.

16th February 2010 - Monthly Faith Dialogue, joint with FN4M, at Sacred Trinity Church, also on the theme "JOURNEYS". Perspectives from Muslims, Christians and Jews who shared a recent journey to Israel and the West Bank.

14th March 2010 - Monthly Faith Dialogue, joint with FN4M, at the Jinnah Centre, Bury also on the theme "JOURNEYS." Ivan Lewis MP talked about his journey from Manchester to Westminster and beyond in the Foreign Office.

29th April 2010 - Faith Youth Manchester: In Your Faith Event at Hideaway Youth Project, Amani Centre.

Several faith awareness sessions at schools and youth groups as part of the 'In Your Faith' project.

Numerous sessions at FN4M's 'Faith in Community Allotment' and the development of the allotment itself into a triple plot.

The MJ Forum also supported by taking part in other organisations' events including the following:

<u>August 2009-</u> Both Cllr Afzal Khan CBE and Jonny Wineberg gave presentations at the Adam Day Event.

<u>November 2009-</u> We entered a team in the Jewish rep Council's Community Quiz at Bowden Synagogue and came 5th out of 24 teams.
