The Directors of The Muslim Jewish Forum of Greater Manchester present their annual report together with the financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2012.

Principal Activities

The objects for which the Forum is established are to develop the cultural and social ties between the Muslim and Jewish Communities of Greater Manchester; to educate members of the Muslim and Jewish Communities in relation to their shared values and common Abrahamic tradition, heritage, history and culture; and to promote better understanding within the wider community of the interests and values that are common to the Muslim and Jewish Communities.

<u>During the year, the Forum has held a number of events to further these objects. They included:</u>

- 19 May 2011- We held an event at Manchester Town Hall at which the guest speaker was the Chief Constable of Greater Manchester, Peter Fahy. The event was attended by approximately 30 people.
- 31 May 2011- We held our seventh lawyers' and accountants' event at Linder Myers Solicitors. The topic was "A Muslim and Jewish Perspective of Post Mortems and Death". The guest speakers were Mr Simon Nelson and Mr Mo Mangeera and the event was attended by approximately 30 people.
- 17 July 2011- We held our fifth inter-faith picnic in Heaton Park. There were 20 attendees.
- 18 September 2011- We held our sixth picnic as an "End of summer" picnic. This was attended by approximately 25 people.
- 9 October 2011- We made our first visit to the British Muslim Heritage Centre. This visit was attended by approximately 30 people.
- 30 October 2011- We visited the Manchester Jewish Museum. This visit was attended by approximately 20 people.
- 20 November 2011- We held our first business networking event at the Manchester Conference Centre. The guest speaker was "Networking Guru" Will Kintish and this event was attended by approximately 50 people.
- 29 January 2012- We held a meal at Pagoda Kosher Chinese Restaurant which was attended by 21 people.
- 27 February 2012- We held our second business networking event at the Central Manchester Fire Station. The guest speakers were business journalists Kevin Feddy and Salina Begum, both from the Manchester Evening News, and the event was attended by approximately 50 people.
- 4 March 2012- We held an arts and drama events day for International Women's Day which was coordinated by Laura Nathan and Nicky Mailer. This was attended by approximately 60 women aged 17 to 75.

- 17 November 2011- We partnered with Greater Manchester Interfaith Network for the event "IF IF Inspiration of Faith, Influence of Faith, Impact of Faith Conference" held at the Jain Temple in Levenshulme, Manchester.

4 December 2011- The Forum entered a team in the Manchester Jewish Rep Council's Community Quiz.
