Principal Activities

- 20th January 2008- Meal at the J.S. kosher restaurant.
- 3rd February 2008- Women only afternoon tea at the Midland Hotel.
- 13th March 2008- 3rd Lawyers and Accountants event on "Wills and Inheritance" sponsored by Linder Myers solicitors.
- 27th March 2008-Medical ethics lecture on organ donation.
- 15th June 2008- Informal Midland Hotel afternoon tea for families.
