The Directors of The Muslim Jewish Forum of Greater Manchester present their annual report together with the financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2018.

Principal Activities

The objects for which the Forum is established are to develop the cultural and social ties between the Muslim and Jewish Communities of Greater Manchester; to educate members of the Muslim and Jewish Communities in relation to their shared values and common Abrahamic tradition, heritage, history and culture; and to promote better understanding within the wider community of the interests and values that are common to the Muslim and Jewish Communities.

During the year, the Forum has held a number of events to further these objects:

- 18 June 2017 We held our annual Iftar. It was hosted by Khizra Mosque. Approximately 60 people attended. The speakers included Mayor of Greater Manchester Andy Burnham, Lord Mayor of Manchester Cllr Eddy Newman, Mayor of Salford Cllr Peter Connor and Afzal Khan CBE MP.
- 23 July 2017 We held our annual picnic in Platt Fields Park to coincide with the Manchester Mega Mela. Approximately 20 people attended.
- 17 September 2017 We held an Asian meal at Al Maidah Restaurant. Approximately 25 people attended.
- 26 October 2017 We held a lawyers' panel event discussing the Prevent strategy. The panel comprised David Berkley QC, Ahmed Nadim, Jeremy Dable and Nasir Hafezi. Approximately 40 people attended.
- 26 November 2017 We held a Twinning event at Salford Civic Centre in Swinton. Rebecca Long Bailey MP was the special guest speaker. Approximately 35 people attended.
- 11 February 2018 We held a kosher meal at Pagoda Kosher Chinese Restaurant. 22 people attended.
- 18 March 2018 We held our third Big Concert. Carol Jason and her band played and we also Ukrainian dancers and Bollywood dancers. It was a huge success and approximately 100 people attended.

The Forum also organised joint events with other interfaith organisations and supported other organisations' events. Some of these are listed below:

- 10 August 2017 Co-Chair Cllr Heather Fletcher and Qaisra Shahraz both spoke at the Adam Day commemoration event.
- 19 November 2017 The Forum entered a team in the Manchester Jewish Representative Council Community Quiz.
- 18 February 2018 Co-Chair Cllr Heather Fletcher spoke at "Visit My Mosque Day" event.

Financial Accounts

The financial accounts, which comprise an Income and Expenditure Account and a Balance Sheet, are set out on the following pages. Due to the small size of the company's turnover and assets, the accounts are not required to be audited.

During the year, the Forum had total receipts of £1,707.37 and total expenditures of £1,341.38 resulting in an overall surplus of £365.99 as detailed in the Income and Expenditure account.

The overall financial position is considered satisfactory.

Charitable status

The Forum is registered as a charity with HM Revenue & Customs with effect from 9 May 2014. Accordingly donors to the Forum who are taxpayers are requested to complete a gift aid declaration which can be downloaded from the "Join us" section of our website. Donors to the Forum who are higher rate taxpayers should be able to claim higher rate tax relief through self-assessment for their donations.
