The Directors of The Muslim Jewish Forum of Greater Manchester present their annual report together with the financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2019.

Principal Activities

The objects for which the Forum is established are to develop the cultural and social ties between the Muslim and Jewish Communities of Greater Manchester; to educate members of the Muslim and Jewish Communities in relation to their shared values and common Abrahamic tradition, heritage, history and culture; and to promote better understanding within the wider community of the interests and values that are common to the Muslim and Jewish Communities.

During the year, the Forum has held a number of events to further these objects:

- 25 May 2018 We held our annual Iftar at Khizra Mosque. The speakers included the Lord Mayor of Manchester, Cllr June Hitchen and the Ceremonial Mayor of Salford Cllr Ronnie Wilson. Approximately 50 people attended
- 5 August 2018 We held our annual picnic at Heaton Park. Approximately 25 people attended
- 7 October 2018 We visited the National Holocaust Museum in Nottinghamshire and heard the Hungarian Holocaust survivor, John Dobai speak. 20 people went on this trip.
- 1 November 2018 We held our annual "Loose Lawyers" panel event. The topic was "Is Ofsted trampling on faith?" The panel comprised Ahmed Nadim, David Berkley QC, Joanne Feldman and Yasmin Aslam. Approximately 50 people attended.
- 13 January 2019 We held our annual kosher meal at Pagoda Chinese Cuisine & Grill in Prestwich. 22 people attended including the Mayor of Bury and her consort who were the Forum's guests.
- 17 March 2019 We held our annual Quiz at Salford Civic Centre in Swinton with quizmasters Steven Pearlman and Jonny Wineberg. 50 people attended.

The Forum also organised joint events with other interfaith organisations and supported other organisations' events. Some of these are listed below:

- 30 June 2018 Co Chair Mohammed Amin attended the Youth Iftar organised by Manchester Cathedral.
- 29 July 2018 The Forum had a table in the exhibition at the annual Peace & Unity Event organised by the Manchester Interfaith Network, with several members of the Executive attending and participating.
- 10 August 2018 Co Chair Cllr Heather Fletcher spoke at Adam Day organised by the Azeemia Foundation.
- 14 March 2019 The Forum organised a table of 10 who attended the Centenary Dinner of the Jewish Representative Council of Greater Manchester & Region at their own expense. The Forum also made a donation to the Rep Council by advertising in the dinner brochure.

Financial Accounts

The financial accounts, which comprise an Income and Expenditure Account and a Balance Sheet, are set out on the following pages. Due to the small size of the company's turnover and assets, the accounts are not required to be audited.

During the year, the Forum had total receipts of £1,753.56 and total expenditures of £1,004.10 resulting in an overall surplus of £749.46 as detailed in the Income and Expenditure account.

The overall financial position is considered satisfactory.

Charitable status

The Forum is registered as a charity with HM Revenue & Customs with effect from 9 May 2014. Accordingly donors to the Forum who are taxpayers are requested to complete a gift aid declaration which can be downloaded from the "Join us" section of our website. Donors to the Forum who are higher rate taxpayers should be able to claim higher rate tax relief through self-assessment for their donations.
