The Directors of The Muslim Jewish Forum of Greater Manchester present their annual report together with the financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2022.

Our purpose

The objects for which the Forum is established are to develop the cultural and social ties between the Muslim and Jewish Communities of Greater Manchester; to educate members of the Muslim and Jewish Communities in relation to their shared values and common Abrahamic tradition, heritage, history and culture; maximising their potential and improving their health and well-being as residents of Greater Manchester; and to promote better understanding within the wider community of the interests and values that are common to the Muslim and Jewish Communities.

Principal activities during the year

During the year, the Forum resumed holding in-person events, as well as continuing to hold some events online where appropriate. When events are held online, we record them and publish appropriate parts on our website. They can all be found via our "News and past events" page.

23 May 2021 – "Migration Stories" held online. About 45 listened to the stories of three Muslims and two Jewish speakers of how they came to be in the UK.

1 August 2021 – Picnic in St Mary's Park, Prestwich. This was our first in-person event for 18 months and was attended by approximately 25 people.

3 October 2021 – Our 15th Anniversary Tea Party. The Forum actually became 15 in June 2020, but the celebration was significantly delayed due to the coronavirus pandemic. We held a fully catered event at Swinton Masonic Hall in Pendlebury with eight prestigious speakers. It was attended by 60 people.

14 November 2021 – "The Languages of Greater Manchester's Muslims and Jews" held online. Emeritus Professor of Linguistics Yaron Matras gave a detailed presentation followed by shorter talks by two Muslims and two Jews whose first language was not English about their personal linguistic journeys. Around 60 people joined the call

27 February 2022 – Kosher meal at Celia's Kitchen in Prestwich. The attendance of 42 people set a record for our annual kosher meal.

Financial accounts

The financial accounts, which comprise an Income and Expenditure Account and a Balance Sheet, are set out on the following pages. Due to the small size of the company's turnover and assets, the accounts are not required to be audited.

During the year, the Forum had total receipts of \pounds 2,413.00 and total expenditures of \pounds 3,696.90 resulting in an overall deficit of \pounds 1,283.90 as detailed in the Income and Expenditure account.

The Forum is registered as a charity with HM Revenue & Customs with effect from 9 May 2014.
